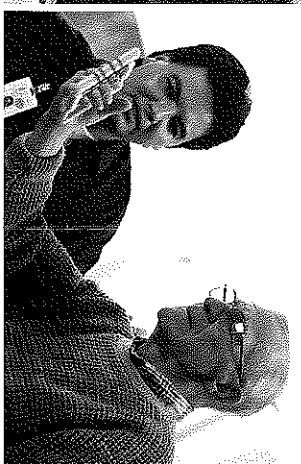
Lutheran Long Term Home Health Care Program.

Elderly people and those with chronic illnesses or disabilities no longer require nursing home placement to get the care they need. A key component in our *Life Enhancing Communities* philosophy of care is the ability to provide each participant with individualized care. Telehealth is the use of electronic information and communication technology to deliver medical information and services through a standard telephone line.

Self monitoring devices such as a blood pressure unit, scale, and pulse oximeter is placed in a patient's home. This service is not a substitute for personal nursing care. It allows us to keep track of the patient's current health status which is monitored around the clock on a daily basis.

Information Technology combined with old-fashioned personal attention enables Lutheran Long Term Home Health Care Program to provide superior health care to our patients. Telehealth is changing the way we think about health and provide healthcare
